Matters Arising From Previous Meeting

- 1) Planning Application for Mr W Wright. The tree preservation order was now in force at the proposed site at Haddlesey House. It was noted that Planning Permission does override Tree Preservation Orders so if a tree was to be removed it had to be replaced.
- 2) Replies were received and distributed from Yorkshire Water and North Yorkshire Fire Service - Regarding the fire at Cowflat Farm on 23.8.91 - Yorkshire Water were to look into the Water Pressure problem and rectify any faults found. North Yorkshire Fire Service explained and justified the delay in reaching the fire.
- 3) Post Office Lane - The lane had been walked on 15.10.91 by John Adams of NYCC Fulford and C Petch. The lane was to be claimed as a Public Footpath yet allowing existing access to farmers with rights of way down the lane. The process was a lengthy one and as no opposition had been received as yet the NYCC will inform us as to when the Review Board are discussing the lane before it is added to the Village Plan.

Item 1

Revised Planning Application for the erection of a single detached dwelling for Mr W Wright on land at Haddlesey House, West Haddlesey.

The Tree Preservation Order was now in force and the access was ~~now~~ directed from the access into the grounds already existing - no adverse comments were received.

Item 2

A letter was received from Selby Community Safety Group - asking for areas of concern to residents in the community to be advised to them and discussed - there were none felt to be in need at the moment.

Item 3

Tree Planting - 12 Alder Trees were received and planted on 2.12.91.

The Council had been contacted regarding the supply of any more and they promised 15-20 more trees in the next 2 weeks.

There being no other business the meeting closed at 8.07 pm.
